Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for Dyer Water System Improvements in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Dyer, located at 305 N. Washington Street, Dyer, Arkansas, 72935. The funding would be used to improve outdated infrastructure and construct new developments to increase efficiency. Specifically, the funding would allow the restoration of the city's primary water storage tank, the replacement of aging asbestos-cement pipes with modern PVC piping, segmented service line replacement, new interconnections to promote redundancy, and the installation of new water meters. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve public health and ensure state and federal compliance through tank restoration and pipe replacement, enhance system efficiency with service line upgrades and new water meters, increase resiliency by constructing system interconnections, allow for continued development of the city, and adequate access to clean water for current residents.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
