I am requesting funding for Gentry Wastewater Improvements in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Gentry, located at 101 W Main Street, Gentry Arkansas, 72734. The funding would be used to improve existing infrastructure at the wastewater treatment plant, including expansion of treatment capacity by 250,000 gallons/day and the construction of a primary interceptor to reduce sewer overflows and provide the capacity for future growth. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will ensure the city's compliance with environmental and public health regulations, enable regional growth, and protect the safety of residents' water systems.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2)
