I am requesting funding for the Jack Williams Veterans Resource Center "Camp Jack" Capital Improvements in fiscal year 2022.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Harrison, Arkansas. The City's address is PO Box 1715 Harrison, Arkansas 72602, and the project is located at 411 South Pine St. Harrison, Arkansas 72601.

The funding would be used for Capital improvements to the Jack Williams Veterans Resource Center or "Camp Jack". Camp Jack is named for Medal of Honor recipient and Harrison native Pharmacist Mate Third Class Jack Williams. It will provide a one-stop assistance center for veterans and their families in five low-income counties in northern Arkansas. This assistance will include VA Claim Assistance, state/local Veteran Service Coordinator workspace, veteran advocacy services, a food & clothing bank, employment assistance workshops, veteran support groups, and much more. The proposed capital improvements include site improvements (parking, driveway, and park pavilion), interior demolition, exterior windows and doors, new HVAC system, electrical and plumbing system upgrade, roof replacement, and exterior brick repair.
